Father Chuck's Corner

Greetings and God's blessings be yours on Trinity Sunday! And Happy Father's Day to all our great Dads. Thanks to all of you for taking care of us and most of all for loving our Moms! Today we are back in Ordinary Time but with a special Sunday feast called Trinity Sunday. The Holy Trinity is the perfect love triangle. In the first reading from Proverbs, we see that wisdom was always with God and shaped the world from the beginning of creation and all for the purpose of the well-being of humanity. ***"The Lord possesses me, the beginning of his ways, the forerunner of his prodigies of long ago; from of old I was poured forth, at the first, before the earth."*** Then in the second reading from Romans we learn that through faith in Jesus Christ, believers have access to God's grace and his many gifts. We learn that through God's grace we even boast of being made spiritually stronger even in hardships. ***"Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through Jesus Christ...."*** And finally, in John's gospel we are given more insight into the Trinity by Jesus declaring that the Spirit of truth will guide us to all truth. ***"Everything that the Father has is mine, for this reason I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you."***

In his farewell discourse, Jesus tries to prepare the apostles for the road ahead, knowing that they, and we, will need discernment to face the many challenges that will come. He completes the love triangle by telling us to watch for the spirit of Truth, the Paraclete. We are reassured that we are held in God's loving intimacy from the beginning of time when all was created for our delight and to the end of time. We will not be left alone. The Holy Spirit will repeat what God has told us again and again, in what we see written in creation, proclaimed by the prophets, and lived in the life of Jesus. The same Spirit will counsel us how to live it out in our time.

When we are faced with choices about how to live according to this Word, we need to figure out what rings true both to the gritty, human Son of God, who walked the dusty roads of the Middle East and touched undesirable people, and the lofty Divine Wisdom written into creation. Today, as we approach the table of the Lord, let us prepare to open our hearts to Wisdom so as to enter the divine love triangle of the Blessed Trinity.

Last weekend was a truly uplifting experience as we celebrated a Parish Ministry Fair on the Feast of Pentecost. The weather was terrific, and the front lawn was a festive atmosphere that greeted the people after each Mass. The ministries were represented at tables with information and an invitation to join. Our church was arrayed with all the parish ministry banners that gave a special pageantry to the occasion along with the Litany of Ministries at the Prayer of the Faithful. Thanks to all who participated and came over after each Mass. Special thanks to the Pastoral Council for coordinating the entire event, and to the Sodality of Our Lady, the Knights of Columbus and the CYO organization for providing all the "free food" that was enjoyed by all.

Congratulations to our Eighth Grade Students of St. Raymond School who celebrated their graduation this past Friday. Your parish is happy and proud of your accomplishments and wish you all the best in high school. We also congratulate your parents and family who have sacrificed and guided you to this moment. And thanks to our school administration, teachers and staff who have also helped you through these very formative years of your lives.



St. Raymond Memorials

Often people ask if there is something they could memorialize in memory of a loved one. Besides having **Mass Intentions**, there are other opportunities for individuals, families and groups to remember a loved one in a tangible and sometimes lasting way. Some of the weekly liturgical memorials that we have are the **Bread and Wine**, the **Rose for Life** and the **Sanctuary Lamp**. These memorials can be arranged at the rectory.


There are also other liturgical items that are seasonal, like the **Christmas** and **Easter Flowers**, the **Paschal Candle**, **Advent Wreath Candles** and other holy items we can use for religious services. Then we also have a certain lasting type of memorial called a **"Memorial Brick"** that can be set in one of four beautiful outside locations. One location is by the **Holy Family Statue** on the front lawn of the rectory, the **St. Teresa Statue** behind the rectory, the **God and Country Memorial** near the front of the church and finally our newest **Padre Pio Statue** on the walkway between the rectory and church. Each location is open for anyone wishing to have such a Memorial Brick placed there.

These bricks are 4" by 8" with up to three lines of text. The donation for each brick is \$250. Anyone wishing to purchase one of these bricks should contact the rectory during regular office hours. Maybe you will consider one of these special places on the grounds of St. Raymond to celebrate life and pay tribute to someone dear to you.

Farewell Father Lawrence...





Wednesday: one First grade teacher



Features include: 2-6 hours of in-home companion care per week. Companions try to engage the person, maybe take a walk, make lunch, play games or simply chat so that the caregiver gets a break (not able to provide personal care or do housework or shopping).

Nassau County residents 60 or older are eligible. Companions are screened and trained.


